What is Inclusive Education?

Our group definition (the course group consisted of seven teachers from Slovakia, The Czech Republic and Hungary):

It is an education which is enabling all children (SEND, gifted, disadvantaged) to learn something new and do interesting activities.

For discussion:

„We should just teach every child the same thing and the same way. That is equality and inclusion, isn't it? “

Discussion outcome: Equality means equality of outcome, not equality of input

Two models of inclusion

Social model	Medical model
-assumes that all differences are normal, society and education needs to adapt to the child	- difference is wrong, education system needs to fix it

Many countries use the combination of the both models, however, the social model is more acceptable in a modern society.

How to help refugees at schools?

- Listen to them
- Assess and judge their needs
- Put them in a beginner programme with a language support
- then join usual classes
- help to settle, integrate and learn
- cooperate with charities
- work with parents, family and community
- celebrate the differences

Listening Activity (activity to train listening)

- it is important to be able to listen all disadvantaged groups without judging and interrupting them
- Activity: listen to your partner what he has to say without interrupting or „back channelling“ for two minutes and you will learn a lot
- Stories to tell: „Why I have become a teacher“, „My best holiday“, „A story of my hair“

All disadvantaged students do not want to be judged, want to be looked at things they can do, want to be challenged.


Motivation


Thoughts of Mr. Roger Fetherston, Education Consultant (Exeter, UK):

- Schools should be not only about education, but also about trust, honesty and caring
- We should not underestimate the power of our words
- Classroom – we, us, together
- Home visits tell a lot about a difficult student and also show teacher’s caring
- Self-esteem of students is deprived when they are not cared about enough
- Important things in learning – influence of parents, student aspiration
- Safe learning does not push students anywhere, they should be challenged
- Failure should not be discussed, it is ok to make mistakes when we learn from them
- Effort of a student counts the most
- Expectations – students need to know what the expectations in their learning are
- Check the learning all the time
- Assessment should be a part of planning
- Do not accept „I don’t know“ answer, give student a hint, help him
